Liliane Lijn: Stardust

Riflemaker and Riflemaker Soho Square

Influenced by her recent residency at Nasa-funded Stardust Mission in California, the American artist (b.1939, New York) shows at Soho Square sculptures made from silicon-based "aerogel", a substance that is 99% air, that contains interstellar and comet particles—stardust. Films and documentary footage of her career since the 1950s shows at the Beak Street venue.
