Srivani Jade specializes in the North Indian classical form of Khayal and other traditional and folk-inspired music like Thumri-Dadra, Tappa and Bhajans. Srivani has performed regularly on stage, radio and television in India from the age of five. Her first solo album of 16th century devotional music released in 2007. Since moving to the United States in 1996, she has performed for venues including Sangati Center, Seattle City Hall, Town Hall Seattle, Northwest Folklife, Utsav, KBCS 91.3FM radio, Spokane Centerstage Theater, and University of Washington.

Manish Pushkale was born in Bhopal, India, in 1973. His work has been shown in two group exhibitions at Aicon Palo Alto: *Middle Edge* in 2008, and *Confluence 2005* in 2005. Pushkale has participated in group shows at Galerie Mueller and Plate, Munich, 2009; Aakriti Art Gallery, Kolkata, 2008; Gallery Beyond, Mumbai, 2008; and M.E.C. Art Gallery, New Delhi, 2006. He has had solo and two-person exhibitions at Bodhi Art Gallery, Mumbai, 2008, and New Delhi, 2006; Gadfly Gallery, Perth, 2005; Maison des Sciences de l'Hommes, Paris, 2003; and Pundole Art Gallery, Mumbai, 2003. The artist lives and works in New Delhi.
